17 if it passes we'll have to make a motion

18 under new business. This is just to amend

19 it just to add it.

20 MR. NOTARI: I'll make that motion.

21 MR. KOMENSKY: I'll second it.

22 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Motion by

23 Councilman Notari, seconded by Councilman

24 Komensky. On the question? Public input?

25 Roll call, please.

1 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilwoman
2 Avvisato?

3 MS. AVVISATO: Yes.

4 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Hoover?

5 MR. HOOVER: Yes.

6 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman
7 Komensky?

8 MR. KOMENSKY: Yes.

9 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman
10 Lettieri?

11 MR. LETTIERI: Yes.

12 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Notari?

13 MR. NOTARI: Yes.

14 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Rinaldi?

15 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Yes. The next
16 item we have is our DPW manager report.

17 Mr. Lenceski is absent. We have his report.
18 If we have any questions we can contact him.

19 Second item is our code
20 enforcement/zoning officer report. He is
21 also absent. We have his report, so if we
22 need anything we can contact him.

23 The third will be our engineer's
24 report, Dave Lopatka. Anything to add? We
25 have your report. Do you have anything else

1 you want to add for us?

2 MR. LOPATKA: I do not.

3 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Anybody have
4 any questions for the engineer?

5 MR. NOTARI: I have a question.
6 Dave, last night in our finance committee
7 meeting we were discussing street paving,
8 and my thought is that we should try to at
9 least pave one of the streets in Austin
10 Heights every time we go through the
11 process. But I also think that we need to
12 have a storm water management plan in place
13 before we do that so when we do go and start
14 digging up roads, we can maybe do those
15 projects at the same time and not pave roads
16 and then three years later, if we're forced
17 to do it --

18 MR. LOPATKA: As long as we have
19 something to tie into.

20 MR. NOTARI: So can we start looking
21 at the Heights especially in terms of where
22 we're going to begin our storm water
23 separation plan?

24 MR. LOPATKA: Sure.

25 MR. NOTARI: Then maybe we can do it

1 in phases. So maybe that's easier for you
2 and for us to start doing it that way.

3 MR. LOPATKA: Okay.

4 MR. NOTARI: I appreciate that.

5 MR. LOPATKA: What roads do we have?

6 MR. HOOVER: I'll let you know. One
7 is Bennett Street, from the top to the
8 bottom. There's so much to do there.
9 There's swales on that road and everything.
10 It's a problem.

11 MR. NOTARI: Mine.

12 MR. HOOVER: There's also Dunn
13 Avenue. Wasn't there a storm water project?
14 In the back of my mind I remember being --

15 MR. LOPATKA: A while back we had
16 done something to route -- where the big
17 hill was, the water going down the hill. We
18 designed something to route it all the way
19 around and come over to Dunn and then down
20 to tie into the one inlet that's off that
21 one alley down below. I think that's where
22 the separation -- the storm system that
23 separates that, and that's where it starts.
24 So there was something done just on the
25 front end of Dunn.

1 MR. HOOVER: I wanted to ask Joe.

2 MR. LOPATKA: We had done something
3 on that.

4 MR. HOOVER: He wants to get
5 something from one side of the intersection
6 down a block to another side of the
7 intersection if we're going to pave that
8 road, not to pave it and then have to do
9 this, like Rick was saying.

10 MR. LOPATKA: I'll find it. We have
11 it. Let me look at what it is. I know we
12 had done some kind of system. It went all
13 the way over. I don't think it needs to go
14 that far. It could be more concentrated
15 just on Dunn.

16 MR. HOOVER: I want to make sure we
17 don't pave the road and then that happens.
18 If we have to take a block or two blocks off
19 of Dunn for now.

20 MR. LOPATKA: It was within the
21 first three blocks. I'll check it.

22 MR. HOOVER: Because those two
23 streets alone are almost \$700,000, Bennett
24 and Dunn.

25 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Anyone else

1 have any questions for the engineer?

2 MR. LETTIERI: Dave, the plans for
3 that dugout are completed? We're just
4 waiting for bids now?

5 MR. LOPATKA: Yeah, we're finalizing
6 the bid, then it will go out to bid.

7 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Anyone else?
8 Thanks, Dave. Chief Dubernas, police
9 report, we have your report. Anything else?

10 CHIEF DUBERNAS: Maxson Drive, three
11 of the cars in question Dave had paperwork
12 submitted to get information on them, but
13 all the other ones are good, including the
14 ten classics that he has there. That's
15 nothing. He has 40-some cars. He has four
16 properties. He was trying to get acreage
17 and build a pole barn to keep them all in.
18 He's battling cancer and everything.

19 MR. HOOVER: Okay. How's things on
20 the hill? It's been quiet.

21 CHIEF DUBERNAS: They cleaned up the
22 place. There's only two cars there.

23 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Anything else,
24 Chief?

25 CHIEF DUBERNAS: That's it.

1 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Anyone have
2 any questions for the chief? Thanks, Chief.

3 Assistant Fire Chief Stull, anything
4 to add for the meeting?

5 MR. STULL: No, just what's in the
6 report.

7 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Anybody have
8 any questions for Mr. Stull? Thanks, Bill.

9 Attorney Rinaldi, solicitor's
10 report, we have it and we have the
11 resolution under new business. Anything
12 else for the evening?

13 ATTY. RINALDI: No.

14 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Anybody have
15 any questions for the solicitor? Thanks,
16 Bill.

17 Marylynn, borough manager's report?

18 MS. BARTOLETTI: I have the 2022
19 budget to tentatively pass tonight, and we
20 have a payment application for the D&M for
21 the building and a payment application for
22 elevator.

23 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Anybody have
24 any questions for the borough manager?

25 MR. NOTARI: I need to go back.

1 Bill, again, something that came up in our
2 finance meeting last night. The sewer
3 agency, are we allowed to dissolve it or is
4 that something we're required to have?

5 ATTY. RINALDI: It's actually part
6 of the borough. You just call it the sewer
7 agency. There's really nothing there but
8 your sewer committee and your collection.
9 You don't have a separate authority for your
10 sewer system. That's all under the borough.

11 MR. NOTARI: That's what we wanted
12 to have happen, so it was more or less just
13 the sewer department --

14 ATTY. RINALDI: It's like a
15 department like zoning. You just call it
16 the agency since I've been here.

17 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Anyone else
18 have any questions? Thanks, Bill. Before
19 we go into new business we'll go to public
20 comment. Joan?

21 MS. WILK: Chief, we talked about
22 making no outlet on that street where the --

23 CHIEF DUBERNAS: West Grace.

24 MS. WILK: Have you checked on that?
25 I think you should not wait for a year now

1 before it gets lost in the shuffle. I think
2 if you're going to do something you
3 should --

4 CHIEF DUBERNAS: We're going to
5 block it. The only thing, on our map they
6 show a paper alley behind your house that
7 goes from behind your house all the way
8 behind the homes to Lawrence Street. I'm
9 not sure if that could be blocked.

10 MS. WILK: No, behind my house was
11 PP&L.

12 CHIEF DUBERNAS: The paper alley
13 shows from Marion Street, goes behind all
14 the homes, behind Ms. Wilk's house, into
15 Rossi's parking lot. It allows access for
16 the homes on the 200 block of West Grace to
17 Lawrence Street. So if we block it, it
18 still allows the homes on the 200 block to
19 go out to Lawrence Street through the
20 parking lot, but it shows, like -- I guess
21 it's a paper alley.

22 MR. NOTARI: Chief, do you think
23 that paper alley is actually in the parking
24 lot on that property?

25 CHIEF DUBERNAS: That's the way it

1 looks. I know their pavement goes all the
2 way back to all the homes there.

3 MS. WILK: The property behind the
4 house was owned by PP&L, which --

5 CHIEF DUBERNAS: It shows more like
6 a right-of-way.

7 MS. WILK: Right, PPL owned that and
8 turned it over to the school district.
9 That's behind my house.

10 CHIEF DUBERNAS: How about behind
11 the houses in the 200 block?

12 MS. WILK: I don't know anything
13 about that.

14 MR. HOOVER: Can't you just put a
15 sign there?

16 MS. WILK: There's cars parked on
17 both sides of the street.

18 MR. HOOVER: Some of those people
19 park in the back.

20 CHIEF DUBERNAS: They would still
21 have access, but they would just have to
22 come in off Lawrence instead of George.

23 MS. AVVISATO: That's better.

24 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Which isn't a
25 bad idea because it stops that traffic just

1 in case, from the loading dock, trucks don't
2 shoot right up. Just put two or three
3 concrete barriers there. I think it's a
4 good idea.

5 CHIEF DUBERNAS: We can definitely
6 put signs at the top of George Street that
7 say dead end.

8 MS. AVVISATO: That's smart.

9 MR. HOOVER: Is this something we
10 have to notify those residents about?

11 CHIEF DUBERNAS: I would do a
12 traffic study and then Bill would have to
13 post it.

14 MR. NOTARI: On the hunting app
15 there's no alley there.

16 MR. HOOVER: There's no alley on
17 Google either.

18 MR. NOTARI: The properties bump up
19 against the school property.

20 MS. WILK: It is school property.

21 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Thanks, Chief.
22 Sandra?

23 MS. CONDON: Sandra Condon. I'm
24 wondering, are recreational vehicles allowed
25 on borough streets?

1 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: ATVs?

2 CHIEF DUBERNAS: ATVs and side by
3 sides?

4 MS. CONDON: I live right on the
5 bend on Oak Street and there is a travel
6 trailer parked in front of my house. This
7 person parked this vehicle in front of my
8 house, which it's a hindrance to me because
9 I can't have any visitors come because
10 there's nowhere to park.

11 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: What kind of
12 vehicle is it?

13 MS. CONDON: It's a travel trailer.
14 It's a camper. Is it registered?

15 CHIEF DUBERNAS: I'm not sure.

16 MS. CONDON: It's a tag along. I'm
17 722 Oak Street.

18 CHIEF DUBERNAS: I'll come there
19 tomorrow morning.

20 MS. CONDON: Since you don't have to
21 get the yearly sticker to say your car is
22 registered --

23 CHIEF DUBERNAS: I'll check it.

24 MS. CONDON: I had the policemen
25 there in September, they did squat. Like I

1 said, I have no place for visitors who come
2 to park. It might be state road property.
3 It's on the shoulder. My next door neighbor
4 talked to him. I don't even know the man's
5 name. He lives in Domiano's old house. He
6 has too many vehicles in his back yard that
7 he can't park it in the back yard.

8 CHIEF DUBERNAS: I know where you're
9 talking about. You live on one side, they
10 live on the other. So they moved it across
11 the street. He has a boat in the yard.

12 MS. CONDON: He has a boat in the
13 yard, a couple motorcycles, there's an old
14 Bronco that has not moved in two years. He
15 has a golf cart in there. He's parking his
16 truck now across the street, and it just
17 seems like I lived there for 40 years and I
18 never had any problems until this past year.

19 CHIEF DUBERNAS: I'll check it
20 tomorrow. If it's registered -- it depends
21 if it's zoned. If it's zoned residential
22 they can, if zoned commercial they can't.
23 I'll find out.

24 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: When he goes
25 tomorrow and runs the plates he'll find out

1 if the vehicle itself is registered and then
2 he'll find the zone.

3 MS. CONDON: My next door neighbor
4 talked to this gentleman and he said this
5 vehicle is there since the last week in
6 August, and my next door neighbor said he's
7 getting company. Normally, if Bob gets
8 company I allow them to park here. If you
9 need more, I'll move my car and they can
10 park in my yard. He went over to talk to
11 the gentleman, and the gentleman told him
12 well, I'll move it next Tuesday. Well, next
13 Tuesday has not come because that was in
14 August. September, October, it's already
15 the middle of November.

16 Last year he did the same thing with
17 his pickup truck, and I wrote a note on his
18 windshield I don't mind you parking there
19 but kindly pull in.

20 Here's another thing. How do you
21 apply for a handicapped parking spot?

22 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: For yourself?

23 MS. CONDON: For myself.

24 MS. BARTOLETTI: You can come to the
25 borough office and get an application. Do

1 you have a placard?

2 MS. CONDON: Yes, I do.

3 MS. BARTOLETTI: So if you come to
4 the borough office we'll begin the
5 application. We go out and inspect to see
6 if you meet the criteria. The application
7 fee is just \$10.

8 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Once the chief
9 finds out some information we'll have him
10 get in touch with you. Thank you.

11 Anyone else from the public before
12 we go into new business? Okay. First item
13 under new business is payment application
14 number 12 payable to D&M Construction. The
15 amount is \$26,321.84. Motion to approve?

16 MR. KOMENSKY: I'll make that
17 motion.

18 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: By Councilman
19 Komensky.

20 MR. HOOVER: I'll second it.

21 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Seconded by
22 Councilman Hoover. On the question? Public
23 input?

24 MS. WILK: Is this the company
25 that's looking for the stone?

1 MR. NOTARI: It's coming tomorrow.

2 MR. ROBERT HART: When I'm sitting
3 here and you guys are voting how do I know
4 what you're voting on?

5 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: You can get a
6 copy of the agenda if you needed one.

7 MR. ROBERT HART: I got one.

8 MS. BARTOLETTI: The last page,
9 under new business.

10 MR. ROBERT HART: But how do I know
11 what that is? What's the \$26,000 for?

12 MR. HOOVER: It's a payment
13 application for the borough building.

14 MR. ROBERT HART: When you're voting
15 on the budget in the beginning of the
16 meeting, you know, how do I know what the
17 budget is?

18 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: When we come
19 around to this and you ask a question,
20 whatever question you have we'll give you
21 the answer.

22 MR. ROBERT HART: In the beginning
23 of every meeting you have your roll call for
24 let's accept the sewer bill. How do I know
25 how much the sewer bill is?

1 MS. BARTOLETTI: Those are all the
2 borough's financial reports that are given
3 to council.

4 MR. ROBERT HART: Right, so it's not
5 public knowledge?

6 MS. BARTOLETTI: It is.

7 ATTY. RINALDI: Yeah, you can ask
8 for copies of it. That's not a problem.

9 MS. BARTOLETTI: What they're doing
10 is voting to approve, so if you want copies,
11 like, tomorrow or the day after the meeting,
12 once they're approved, you can always come
13 to the borough building and request that.

14 MS. WILK: He wants one prior to.

15 MS. BARTOLETTI: They're not
16 approved yet. Just like minutes. They vote
17 to approve minutes. They're not eligible to
18 be given to the public until after they're
19 official. So after the meeting, like the
20 next day or whatever, is when things like
21 that are usually able to be given to the
22 public.

23 MR. NOTARI: Bob, the budget's just
24 tentative so far. What we're voting on is a
25 tentative budget. When we vote on it you

1 can see it.

2 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Any other
3 public comment? Roll call, please.

4 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilwoman
5 Avvisato?

6 MS. AVVISATO: Yes.

7 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Hoover?

8 MR. HOOVER: Yes.

9 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman
10 Komensky?

11 MR. KOMENSKY: Yes.

12 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman
13 Lettieri?

14 MR. LETTIERI: Yes.

15 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Notari?

16 MR. NOTARI: Yes.

17 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Rinaldi?

18 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Yes. Second
19 item under new business is payment
20 application eight entitled "elevator."
21 Payment to D&M Construction in the amount of
22 \$12,523.50. Motion to approve.

23 MR. HOOVER: This is going to the
24 county?

25 MS. BARTOLETTI: Yes, county CDBG

1 fund.

2 MS. AVVISATO: I'll make that
3 motion.

4 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: By
5 Councilwoman Avvisato.

6 MR. KOMENSKY: I'll second it.

7 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Seconded by
8 Councilman Komensky. On the question?
9 Public input? Roll call, please.

10 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilwoman
11 Avvisato?

12 MS. AVVISATO: Yes.

13 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Hoover?

14 MR. HOOVER: Yes.

15 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman
16 Komensky?
