

1 where there's some kind of money, and I told
2 him anything they need and he wants to do is
3 fine with me.

4 I went to introduce myself to Mayor
5 Segilia down in Moosic last week. He wasn't
6 there. I left a card. Same with Mayor Moss
7 from Duryea. I thought it was a good idea
8 to introduce myself, maybe a little public
9 relations, let them know if they have
10 anything going on I -- I didn't rope council
11 in. I told him if there's anything I can
12 do, I'd be more than happy to do it. That
13 is about it.

14 By the way, I owe you an apology.
15 Last night I was asked to come to that
16 meeting. I didn't know it was a regular
17 school board meeting. Mrs. Wilk led me to
18 believe it was for SRO. I didn't know they
19 had all that business. I had to leave.

20 MR. SEMENZA: No explanation needed.

21 MAYOR LEGG: That's all I have.

22 Thank you.

23 MR. SEMENZA: Thank you, Mayor.

24 Councilman Notari?

25 MR. NOTARI: First off, I'd like to

1 report as Lackawanna County that our summer
2 clinics and spring clinics are coming up,
3 and I'll have that information out to
4 Marylynn as soon as I get it.

5 But there is a winter golf clinic
6 going on at Good Will Industries four nights
7 a week for adults, Monday through Thursday.
8 Friday nights for children. It began
9 Monday, but if you want to start up you're
10 welcome to. It's a nice clinic. I think
11 it's only \$40. It runs for four weeks, if
12 anybody is looking to get into golf. So
13 that's my Lackawanna County business.

14 In terms of borough business, the
15 sewer committee met January 29th. I
16 provided you with some minutes. We
17 discussed personnel of the department. I
18 think we were all in agreement that we'd
19 like to add that part-time person in the
20 department to try to help Lucille with some
21 of the work and also to give us an all-day
22 presence in that office for people to come
23 in and pay their sewer bills instead of only
24 a few hours a day. Also, it would
25 alleviate, if we were able to do that,

1 paying the bank to take payments. Whereas,
2 people would just be ale to come to the
3 borough. Possibly that would allow us to
4 schedule Saturday hours.

5 So I guess what I'm looking for is
6 council -- I know we talked about this ad
7 nauseam. More or less, I guess we need to
8 know what is budgeted exactly and what we
9 feel we can pay for a part-time person going
10 forward. So hopefully at the next work
11 session we can have those numbers for
12 Marylynn. If you can break that down, maybe
13 what it was in the past and what we
14 currently have budgeted, and we can come up
15 with a decision and maybe at the next
16 meeting post to hire someone in that office.

17 We also discussed bills and payment
18 plans and how they are sent out and how
19 they're made in terms of people who are late
20 with payments, and what I was told by
21 Mrs. Yeager is that pretty much people that
22 are on a payment plan pay what they can.

23 I think the committee was of the
24 opinion that we should come up with a set
25 payment plan, whether it be a percentage,

1 whether it be an amount. I know I looked
2 into some different things and I know Mr.
3 Hoover was going to look into the water
4 company to see how they did it. Hopefully,
5 at our next work session we'll be able to
6 discuss those things.

7 We also discussed the sewer
8 commission, which I'm kind of pushing.
9 Mrs. Yeager has recommended, I know, to me
10 and I informed the other two members of the
11 committee that she doesn't feel that
12 commission is necessarily needed any longer
13 in the borough. So I'm willing to let that
14 die unless council has some other thoughts
15 on that.

16 Other than that, that's our borough
17 sewer committee report from that meeting.

18 Some other questions that I have.
19 Do we know if the borough is represented at
20 LLVSA meetings every month?

21 MR. SEMENZA: Yes.

22 MR. NOTARI: I know Mr. Scarnato was
23 on the board.

24 MR. SEMENZA: He is on the board
25 still.

1 MR. NOTARI: Do we feel that we
2 should get a report from him or we should
3 give him things to question or to discuss?

4 MR. SEMENZA: I, not long ago, had
5 Marylynn's office send out a letter to
6 Mr. Scarnato stating that I wanted him here
7 for council meetings. What I got back was
8 it was tough for him to get here because his
9 wife was sick, and I told him -- at that
10 point in time I said to the executive
11 director and I said if council needs
12 anything or any questions we will go
13 directly to him because I have a good
14 relation with Jack and Frank. If you do
15 need anything, I mean --

16 MR. NOTARI: I was just looking
17 through the minutes, and I know there was
18 one meeting we weren't represented. Maybe
19 he was sick or something happened. So I was
20 just wondering if it's ever been something
21 where we need representation there or they
22 need to be informing us of something.

23 MR. SEMENZA: When is his term up,
24 Marylynn? Wasn't he just reappointed two
25 years ago?

1 MS. BARTOLETTI: I believe it was in
2 2015 everybody reappointed him as the
3 borough's representative.

4 MR. SEMENZA: December of '15, I
5 believe. Is it a four-year term or a
6 five-year term?

7 MS. BARTOLETTI: I believe it's
8 four.

9 MR. NOTARI: That was my question on
10 that.

11 MS. BARTOLETTI: I believe he's now
12 the secretary.

13 MR. NOTARI: According to the
14 minutes he's the assistant
15 secretary/treasurer.

16 MR. SEMENZA: Actually, I believe
17 it's a five-year term because there's five
18 boroughs involved.

19 MR. NOTARI: I had a resident
20 approach me about plowing snow into a drain
21 near his house. Ted Minella on Moosic Road.

22 MR. PAPI: We don't plow Moosic
23 Road.

24 MR. NOTARI: That side street. He's
25 on that corner as you come past Gavin's Auto

1 coming up Moosic Road. Right on the corner.

2 CHIEF DUBERNAS: Race Street.

3 MR. NOTARI: Is there a drain at
4 that corner? Just take a look at it.

5 MR. PAPI: There is a drain at the
6 corner.

7 MR. NOTARI: He accused the borough
8 of plowing snow into that drain. I'm just
9 bringing it up. Take a look at it and see.

10 MR. PAPI: I'll go see him tomorrow.

11 MR. NOTARI: Also, we were talking
12 about paving before, and I don't know if
13 we're going to get to the paving program or
14 not, but Baker Street, between Dunn and
15 McClure, is a war zone. So once the
16 weather -- I mean, it's going to be nice the
17 next two days and then it's getting nasty
18 again. Take a look.

19 MR. PAPI: I had the guys out all
20 day Thursday and Friday.

21 MR. NOTARI: It's almost like I
22 can't believe it wasn't paved as part of the
23 last project. That's how bad it was.

24 Again, I know we discussed it a
25 little bit this afternoon and I know I

1 brought it up before, but I would like to
2 have the agenda 24 hours before the meeting,
3 so that way I know what's on it and I know
4 what to prepare for and I know that if
5 there's anything I want brought up that
6 maybe we can add to it. I know sometimes we
7 don't make the decision of what's on the
8 agenda until that night, when we have
9 discussions, or something comes up, but I
10 think every councilman deserves to have an
11 agenda in their possession at least 24 hours
12 before our regular meetings. That's all I
13 have for now.

14 MR. SEMENZA: Council Rinaldi?

15 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: The only thing
16 I have is I'd like to set up a finance
17 meeting. I know you were asking for one
18 last week.

19 MS. BARTOLETTI: A while ago.

20 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: I want to
21 discuss what Councilman Notari said, the
22 position for the sewer, what we're budgeted
23 for in that.

24 Also, the equipment for the
25 telecommunications resolution. I don't know

1 how much any of that cost. We can have that
2 prepared.

3 MS. BARTOLETTI: That's fine.

4 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: You already
5 have it?

6 MS. BARTOLETTI: I don't have it. I
7 have something ordered.

8 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: To discuss the
9 price. Then we can get the wording correct
10 so we can have it in place for next meeting.

Also, we are budgeted for additional full time police officers already?

13 MS. BARTOLETTI: The two that we
14 have been discussing, yes.

15 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: That's all.

16 MR. SEMENZA: Thank you, Councilman
17 Rinaldi. Councilman Ferrett, anything to
18 address council with?

19 MR. FERRETT: Well, the only thing I
20 wanted to bring up is, as I said two months
21 ago, that every councilman should go to work
22 and have some kind of an idea that they want
23 to put on the table and everything. I
24 realize at the last meeting I forgot all
25 about it, but I really think that, in my

1 point of view, what I want to bring up this
2 year is that I think we could have a good,
3 sound maintenance program, see to it that
4 our streets are going to be in better
5 condition.

6 Before I get into details about
7 that, I would like to go to work and
8 schedule a meeting with my two colleagues,
9 Mr. Hoover and Mr. Rinaldi, so we can
10 discuss all the features and then present it
11 to the borough manager and to council, and
12 then we can take it from that point because
13 I think it's something that we should be
14 able to do ourselves rather than sending it
15 out for the bids and everything because we
16 can save ourselves an awful lot of money.

17 Bill, I got to ask you a question,
18 and correct me if I'm wrong. According to
19 the code book and everything, are we allowed
20 to put a resolution to supersede the code,
21 an item in the code or anything? How do we
22 go about this?

23 ATTY. RINALDI: Are you talking
24 about our code or about the state borough
25 code?

1 MR. FERRETT: Probably the state
2 borough code.

3 ATTY. RINALDI: You can only do what
4 they allow you to do, so you'd have to give
5 me something specific. What section do you
6 want --

7 MR. FERRETT: What I'm interested in
8 is, I thought maybe we can put a resolution
9 on that I think council should get a raise.
10 We didn't get a raise in 35 years.

11 ATTY. RINALDI: You can't vote on
12 your own raises.

13 MR. FERRETT: You can't put a
14 resolution on or anything?

15 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: I think we
16 should donate our pay.

17 MR. SEMENZA: Councilman Hoover?

18 MR. HOOVER: I've been going over
19 the engineers that we have coming up. When
20 is that going to be settled? Do we know?

21 MR. SEMENZA: It's not on our agenda
22 tonight. I'd like to actually discuss it in
23 executive session. We're going to have a
24 brief one after this. Do you want to
25 discuss it afterwards?

1 MR. HOOVER: We can. I'd like to
2 make a motion that -- just going over the
3 records of the solicitor and the borough
4 engineer that we have, that they get a lot
5 of phone calls, unnecessary phone calls from
6 everyone, and that's time. That's money
7 that the borough has to pay. Bad enough we
8 have a budget that we can only do three or
9 four projects a year at a time. If seven
10 councilmen are calling him for seven
11 different projects we're not going to get
12 those three projects done.

13 I'm going to make a motion that we
14 only have two people contact the engineer.
15 If borough council members have something,
16 either go to you or go to Marylynn. That
17 way we don't have seven councilmen calling
18 Dave, seven councilman calling Billy. Maybe
19 it will cut down.

20 In 2016, the budget for the engineer
21 was \$25,000. We paid 51. In 2017 it was
22 \$26,000, we paid 53. There's got to be a
23 lot of phone calls and things like that
24 getting involved.

25 MR. LOPATKA: There was a lot of

1 projects.

2 MR. HOOVER: But we have to be able
3 to prioritize them, too.

4 MR. NOTARI: Is that a motion? I'll
5 second it.

6 MR. SEMENZA: Motion by Councilman
7 Hoover to only go through the chairman of
8 the council or through the borough manager
9 to our engineer and our solicitor. Motion
10 by Councilman Hoover, seconded by Councilman
11 Notari. On the question?

12 MR. FERRETT: If only those two
13 people are going to be asking questions,
14 what happens if you're involved in some kind
15 of a program -- say, for instance, the
16 paving program. Why wouldn't the chairman
17 of the committee be allowed to ask questions
18 with the engineer or get involved --

19 MR. SEMENZA: I think what
20 Councilman Hoover is saying here is that
21 it's being taken advantage of, that some
22 people are calling them way too often. I
23 guess at that time and place you want us to
24 come here and sit with Marylynn and say
25 let's call Bill or call Dave and I need

1 these answers. You can do that.

2 MR. HOOVER: When there's a paving
3 project going on Dave's going to be there or
4 you're going to be there. Someone's going
5 to be there spot checking them. So you can
6 make those decisions. If something else has
7 to be done in regard to pave, you have to do
8 more pave, you can pick up the phone and
9 call Marylynn or Bobby.

10 MR. FERRETT: I don't have no
11 problem. I just want to make sure which
12 direction we're going because there's no
13 question or doubt about it, if you look at
14 last year's record and everything, Dave's
15 been acting on the same project two or three
16 times because the same person's calling Dave
17 two, three times. Those monies add up all
18 the time.

19 MR. SEMENZA: Absolutely. That's
20 what he's trying to do. Public input?

21 MR. NOTARI: Not necessarily to add
22 to the motion, but I would ask our solicitor
23 and our engineer that they do not take calls
24 from council members other than the chairman
25 or anyone from the borough other than the

1 borough manager.

2 MR. LOPATKA: Fine by me.

3 MR. NOTARI: I think that makes
4 everything a lot easier for everybody.

5 MR. SEMENZA: Public input? Roll
6 call, please.

7 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Ferrett?

8 MR. FERRETT: Yes.

9 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Hoover?

10 MR. HOOVER: Yes.

11 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Notari?

12 MR. NOTARI: Yes.

13 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Rinaldi?

14 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Yes.

15 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman

16 Lenceski?

17 MR. LENCESKI: Yes.

18 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Semenza?

19 MR. SEMENZA: Yes.

20 MR. HOOVER: One more thing. I do
21 have a couple projects we're going to be
22 doing this year for the water company, so
23 I'll get you those maps.

24 Also, I'm waiting for the PennDOT
25 permit to come back for Moosic Road. We'll

1 be putting a water main in Moosic Road, from
2 Main Avenue to Hoover Street. As soon as I
3 get the permit I'll be able to bid it and
4 get that project done. PennDOT is supposed
5 to pave from Keyser Avenue, Oak Street,
6 little piece of Main Street, then all the
7 way down Moosic Road to Main Street in
8 Moosic. That's the paving project this
9 year.

10 MR. NOTARI: Wasn't it just done?

11 MR. HOOVER: No.

12 MR. SEMENZA: Thank you. Councilman
13 Lenceski?

14 MR. LENCESKI: Nothing at this time.

15 MR. SEMENZA: Myself, I'm going to
16 ask our engineer to give us a cost estimate
17 on putting a community center over at Marion
18 Street Park. I spoke with him today and I
19 asked him on an average -- they've done some
20 community centers throughout the area, and
21 maybe give us a couple different ideas,
22 Dave, if council agrees with that. Does
23 anybody object to him giving us cost
24 estimates on putting up a building over
25 there?

1 MR. NOTARI: I don't have an
2 objection, but what are our specifics for
3 that building?

4 MR. SEMENZA: That's something we
5 have to determine.

6 MS. BARTOLETTI: I think we should
7 wait until we have an engineer in place.

8 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: We do have one
9 in place.

10 MR. PAPI: There's sewer and water
11 and everything already set up in that spot.
12 The road going into the school, it's on the
13 northern side.

14 MR. SEMENZA: If wanted to, I'd want
15 it up top, in the front. Move the tennis
16 court.

17 MR. NOTARI: I have no problem
18 looking into it. Can we discuss it at the
19 work session?

20 MR. SEMENZA: We could. Dave,
21 scratch that.

22 MR. NOTARI: I think it's a great
23 idea.

24 MR. SEMENZA: I have nothing more.
25 At this time the chair would entertain a

1 motion to pass a resolution approving the
2 collective bargaining agreement by and
3 between Old Forge Borough and the Old Forge
4 Borough Police Officers Association for the
5 borough of Old Forge, Lackawanna County,
6 Pennsylvania.

7 MR. NOTARI: I'll make that motion.

8 MR. SEMENZA: By Councilman Notari.
9 May I have a second?

10 MR. LENCESKI: I'll second that.

11 MR. SEMENZA: Seconded by Councilman
12 Lenceski. On the question? Public input?
13 Roll call, please.

14 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Ferrett?

15 MR. FERRETT: No. The reason I'm
16 voting no is because of the fact that I'm
17 not quite satisfied with one article in the
18 contract. I'm not against the contract, I'm
19 not against the hiring of the police, but
20 I'm really against the fact that part-timers
21 are getting \$19.95, the same price as a
22 policeman. I really think that you're going
23 to find out that sooner or later this may
24 come back and bite you, that when this
25 contract is over this may be a sticking

1 point that the police are going to use
2 against the borough when they have the next
3 contract coming up.

4 MR. SEMENZA: Okay.

5 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Hoover?

6 MR. HOOVER: Yes.

7 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Notari?

8 MR. NOTARI: Yes.

9 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Rinaldi?

10 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Yes.

11 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman

12 Lenceski?

13 MR. LENCESKI: Yes.

14 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Semenza?

15 MR. SEMENZA: Yes. We have nothing
16 else on the agenda.

17 MR. NOTARI: I'd like to make a
18 motion to hire two full time police officers
19 on recommendation of the chief and the
20 mayor.

21 MR. SEMENZA: Does the chief want to
22 stand up and give a recommendation?

23 CHIEF DUBERNAS: The first
24 recommendation would be a current 32-hour
25 officer, Dennis Terhune.

1 MR. SEMENZA: We'll do them
2 separately.

3 MR NOTARI: I'd like to make a
4 motion to hire Dennis Terhune as a full-time
5 police officer in the borough of Old Forge.

6 MR. SEMENZA: Motion by Councilman
7 Notari to hire Dennis Terhune as a full time
8 police officer for the Old Forge Borough.
9 May I have a second?

10 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: I'll second
11 it.

12 MR. SEMENZA: Seconded by Councilman
13 Rinaldi. On the question? Public input?
14 Roll call, please.

15 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Ferrett?

16 MR. FERRETT: Yes.

17 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Hoover?

18 MR. HOOVER: Yes.

19 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Notari?

20 MR. NOTARI: Yes.

21 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Rinaldi?

22 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Yes.

23 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman

24 Lenceski?

25 MR. LENCESKI: Yes.

1 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Semenza?

2 MR. SEMENZA: Yes. The next name?

3 CHIEF DUBERNAS: Jacob Thomas.

4 Currently been working for the last two
5 years here. He mostly works nights and
6 second shifts.

7 MR. NOTARI: I'd like to make a
8 motion to hire Jacob Thomas as a full time
9 police officer for the borough of Old Forge.

10 MR. SEMENZA: Motion by Councilman
11 Notari to hire Jacob Thomas as a full time
12 police officer for the Old Fore Borough
13 Police.

14 MR. HOOVER: I'll second it.

15 MR. SEMENZA: Seconded by Councilman
16 Hoover. On the question? Public input?
17 Roll call, please.

18 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Ferrett?

19 MR. FERRETT: Yes.

20 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Hoover?

21 MR. HOOVER: Yes.

22 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Notari?

23 MR. NOTARI: Yes.

24 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Rinaldi?

25 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Yes.

12 MR. HOOVER: I'll second it.

13 MR. SEMENZA: Seconded by Councilman
14 Hoover. On the question? Public input?
15 Roll call, please.

16 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Ferrett?

17 MR. FERRETT: Abstain.

18 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Hoover?

19 MR. HOOVER: Yes.

20 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Notari?

21 MR. NOTARI: No.

22 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Rinaldi?

23 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: Yes.

24 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman
25 Lenceski?

1 MR. LENCESKI: No.

2 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Semenza?

4 anything else?

6 to two?

7 MS. BARTOLETTI: Yes.

9 put a motion to the floor to hire BIU as Old
10 Forge Borough's third-party inspector.

11 MR. SEMENZA: Motion by Councilman
12 Rinaldi to hire BIU as Old Forge Borough
13 third-party inspection company.

14 MR NOTARI: I'll second that motion.

15 MR. SEMENZA: Seconded by Councilman
16 Notari. On the question? Public input?
17 Roll call, please.

18 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Ferrett?

19 MR. FERRETT: Yes.

20 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Hoover?

21 MR. HOOVER: Yes.

22 MS. BARTOLETTI: Councilman Notari?

23 MR. NOTARI: Yes.

15 MR. HOOVER: I'll make the motion.

14 A. R. Popple for \$96,000.

15 MR. SEMENZA: Motion by Councilman
16 Notari to award the Grace Street project to
17 A. R. Popple for the amount of \$96,000.

18 MR. LOPATKA: The low bidder was
19 TSE.

20 MR. SEMENZA: Don't we have to go
21 with the low bidder?

22 MR. NOTARI: Low and responsible.
23 Correct?

24 ATTY. RINALDI: Low and responsible.
25 I don't know what kind of review you did.

1 That's up to you guys.

2 MR. SEMENZA: Motion by Councilman
3 Notari. Can I have a second? Motion fails.
4 Do we have any other motions?

5 The chair is going to ask for a
6 motion to hire TSE for the Grace Street
7 project at the price of \$81,222.

8 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: I'll make that
9 motion because I've always been told by the
10 solicitor that we had to accept the lowest
11 bidder.

12 MR. SEMENZA: Motion by Councilman
13 Rinaldi to hire TSE in the amount of
14 \$81,222. I'd ask for a second. Motion
15 fails. I'm going to re-ask you to do a cost
16 estimate for --

17 MR. LOPATKA: Rebid --

18 MR. SEMENZA: No, cost estimate for
19 a community center. Actually just get us
20 some ideas beforehand, a couple different
21 sizes. Couple ideas you guys have done over
22 the years, if everybody's in agreement with
23 that. Anybody object to that?

24 MR. NOTARI: No.

25 MR. SEMENZA: Thank you. At this

1 time, if nobody has anything else, the chair
2 will make a motion to adjourn.

3 MR. RUSSELL RINALDI: I'll make that
4 motion.

5 MR. SEMENZA: By Councilman Rinaldi.
6 All in favor?
